PART I: ADMINISTRATION REPORT

1.1 Introduction

The Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) examination is a syllabus-based assessment where candidates are awarded certificates in respect of each syllabus sat for. The examination was administered to **36 557** candidates from 02 October to 25 November 2020. The 2020 cohort was comprised of candidates from public schools, private schools and individual candidates who registered directly with BEC. The 2020 examinations were conducted under the COVID-19 environment. Despite the challenges with COVID-19, the conduct of examinations went relatively well, except for a few recorded incidents.

1.2 Registration

Registration at this level was conducted through the online facility for both school and private candidates. All centres managed to register at their respective schools this year, while some of the private candidates had to come to BEC for assistance, especially after the lockdown period when the registration period was extended.

1.2.1 Registration of centres

There were 80 centres that registered candidates for the 2020 BGCSE examination, compared to 76 in 2019. These were categorised as follows; 54 school centres (34 government schools and 20 private schools) and 26 private centres (16 BOU and 10 BEC). BOU registered three (3) more centres and there was one more private school that registered candidates.

1.2.2 Registration of candidates

Table 1.1 below shows the number of candidates who registered for the BGCSE examination in 2020 by centre type. The number of candidates was more or less the same as that of 2019 with a very small increase from 36 508 in 2019 to 36 557 in 2020. Government school candidature increased by about 4.8%, private school candidates decreased by about 40% while there was a notable increase of about 14.5% in BOU candidates.

1.3 Conduct of the Examinations under COVID-19 Environment

1.3.1 Administration of Examinations

In addition to regular documents that are issued to centres to help them administer examinations, guidelines were developed for centres on how best to handle the conduct of examinations with the threat of COVID-19. These were very helpful in standardising the administration of examinations across the centres during the pandemic as well as ensuring adherence to health protocols.

All in all, BEC worked closely with the District Health Management Teams, the Regional Education Directors and medical doctors to ensure that every candidate reported as a contact or with COVID-19 were able to access the 2020 examinations. In all, BGCSE recorded a total of eighty-three (83) candidates who were able to access their examinations while under quarantine or isolation conditions.

1.3.2 Compliance to Examination regulations

As a requirement for accreditation by Cambridge International, an inspector is sent each year during the administration to verify that the examinations are being conducted according to regulatory requirements. Due to travel restrictions effected by countries in response to the COVID-19, the Cambridge inspectors could not be engaged for the 2020 examinations cycle. To ensure continuity however, Cambridge International engaged the BEC Compliance and Quality Assurance Division to perform inspections of live examinations on their behalf.

A total of 18 centres were inspected during the 2020 series. The inspections commenced on the 19th of October until the 6th of November 2020. The results showed a significant decline at the “satisfactory with minor points” rating of 71% in 2019 to 33% in 2020 with a significant increase in the rating of “serious deficiencies” from 0% in 2019 to 33% in 2020. Although it could not be confirmed, the impact of COVID-19 on preparation for conduct of examinations and the ratings herein could not be ruled out. The issue of secure storage still comes up as the main cause for centres being rated low.

It was reported that despite the findings of the inspections above, the BGCSE examinations were largely conducted in a manner consistent with the standards, rules and regulations.

1.4 Malpractice and maladministration cases

For the 2020 examination series, three (3) cases of alleged malpractice were reported at BGCSE compared four (4) case in 2019. Two of the cases involved the submission of similar or identical work for coursework, which is a recurring problem across years at both JCE and BGCSE and the third case involved a candidate who brought unauthorized material into the examination room. There was also one (1) case of mal-administration and in addition five (5) incidents were reported. The one case of mal administration involved opening of wrong question paper packet while the incidents were varied.

All the incidents have been adequately dealt with and cleared during the time of examination processing.

1.5 Marking and Moderation

1.5.1 Moderation

Moderation of coursework at this level went relatively well. There were no challenges regarding moderator numbers. For centre-based moderation, the moderators were assigned centres within their zones. For the centrally moderated components, four components were housed in the green zone while two were housed in the red zone. There were fewer number of none and late submissions as compared to 2019.

1.5.3 Marking

1.5.3.1 Recruitment of examiners

Examiners were recruited from across the country to mark candidates' scripts in four marking centres across the country. The creation of multiple venues was an effort to reduce number of examining personnel per marking venue and to better address the COVID-19 health protocols. A total of one thousand three hundred and forty-four (1 344) were engaged compared to 1 294 in 2019, recording a 7.7% increase. Overall the turn up during the COVID-19 year was better than the previous year. Even though the overall turn up was better than the previous year, there were still shortage of examiners recorded for some components.

1.5.3.2 Marking Exercise

The marking exercise was scheduled to run from 11 to 24 December 2020. Most components were able to complete marking by 24 December 2020 with the exception of Commerce Papers 1 and 2 that completed marking on 25 December, Setswana Paper 1 that completed on 29 December and History Paper 1 that completed marking by 15 January 2021. There were generally no issues raised during this marking session except for enquiries on the review of script fees for some components.

1.6 Candidates with Special Needs

1.6.1 Applications for Access Arrangements

A total of 375 applications were received in 2020 compared to 295 in 2019 as shown in Table 1.2 below. Out of the 375 applications, 86.7% of the candidates provided supporting evidence and 13.3% did not. There was a decrease in provision of supporting evidence when compared to 2019 where 95.0% provided the evidence required.

All candidates who applied for access arrangements at this level were deemed to be eligible and their applications were approved. Those who did not provide the evidence up to the time of the examinations could not be granted the arrangements.

1.6.2 Applications by Special Needs Type and Access Arrangement Type

The applications received this year were more of the same special needs type as those received in previous years. But there was an increase noted in the number of candidates who requested the use of a scribe/writer and reader.

Table 1.3 below shows the types of access arrangements. There was a notable decline in applications for Rest breaks, Enlarged Print, Modified Papers. The greatest increase was noted for those that requested for reader and oral response/scribe/writer.

1.6.3 Applications for Special Consideration

A total of eighty-six (86) applications were received in 2020 compared to fifty-two (52) received in 2019. This was an increase of sixty-five percent (65%). The increase in applications could be attributed to the COVID-19 pandemic as fifty seven percent (57%) of the applications were COVID-19 related. Candidates sat their examinations either on quarantine or in isolation.

PART II: TECHNICAL REPORT

2.1 Introduction

This part of the report uses data from candidates on full time attendance at government schools only as it is considered to be a stable population and therefore enables reliable comparisons across years. The BGCSE results are used mainly for selection to tertiary institutions and or awarding of sponsorships to the same.

The assessment structure for 2020 was the same as that of 2019 which comprised of twenty-seven (27) BGCSE syllabuses and three (3) syllabuses borrowed from Cambridge International. The 27 BGCSE syllabuses had a total of seventy-one (71) components comprising Multiple-Choice, coursework and constructed response.

The grades awarded in each syllabus are on a scale of A* to G, where A* represents the highest level of performance and G the lowest. Candidates failing to reach the minimum requirements for grade G are ungraded, hence assigned letter U. Whilst grades G or better represent success at different levels in a given syllabus, those that are C or better are classified as credits and the band C or better is used as a measure of quality.

It should be noted that the 2020 examination series provided candidates with an opportunity to show what they know and what they can do and to the same level of demand as those who took the examination in previous years. However, the 2020 cohort had to show what they know and what they can do under an exceptionally different environment (COVID-19 pandemic) which would likely impact negatively on their performance. In syllabuses where this was evident, an established post examination procedure used internationally was applied at a national level. Application of the procedure meant that slightly less marks were required to qualify for a particular grade compared to the same grade last year as the cohort potentially had reduced chances of demonstrating what they know and can do due to circumstances beyond their control. Demanding the same mark from both cohorts would have undermined the principle of Fairness in examinations which requires that all candidates be given the same opportunity to achieve the right grade, irrespective of which exam series they take and this was not the case for the 2020 cohort.

2.2 Grading

2.2.1 Process

As in previous years, the grading procedure used a combination of professional judgement and statistical evidence. It involved participation of stakeholders and this year representatives were from Department of Curriculum Development & Evaluation, University of Botswana, Botswana Open University and a representative from Cambridge International as required by the accreditation agreement between the two parties. The pieces of evidence used in validating awarding decisions included the use of Syllabus Pairs Comparisons, comparability studies against the relevant IGCSE syllabus and Changes in Forecast grades.

2.3 Validation of Prospective Results

In addition to usual checks conducted before the issue of results, which involve centres flagged for possible malpractice in previous years, those with alleged malpractice in the current year and those presenting drastic changes in performance from the previous year, performance of centres in Greater Gaborone COVID-19 zone was interrogated and the outcome indicated that the zone was not affected in anyway different from the rest of the zones.

2.4 Final Outcome

This section reports performance at syllabus and overall levels.

2.4.1 Performance at syllabus level

Performance at syllabus level is reported at Grades G or better, E or better and C or better.

Grade G or better

A total of six (6) syllabuses recorded significant changes at Grade G or better compared to only four in 2019. The syllabuses with significant changes at this level are Science Single Award, Science Double Award, Geography, Literature in English, Accounting and Business Studies. All these have recorded significant declines except Accounting which has recorded a significant improvement at this grade level. This implies that for the other five (5) syllabuses, the proportion of candidates assigned letter U is higher than in 2019.

Grade E or better

Only one syllabus, Religious Education, recorded a significant decline at this grade level. The rest of the syllabuses recorded insignificant improvements or declines. In 2019, no syllabus recorded a significant decline at this level, instead ten syllabuses recorded a significant improvement at this level. This implies that the performance at this grade level across syllabuses is generally lower than in 2019.

Grade C or better

The performance at this grade level shows insignificant decline or improvement across all syllabuses except for Art & Design which has recorded a significant improvement. The syllabus recorded more than 70% of candidates at this grade level leading to an improvement of about 6% from 2019.

The section that follows largely presents insignificant changes as observed across syllabuses.

2.4.2 Syllabus specific reports

The syllabus specific reports are presented according to the classification in the curriculum blueprint. The blueprint classifies syllabuses into two broad groups of Core and Optional. The optional group is further divided into 4 subgroups as follows:

- Sciences
- Humanities and Social Sciences
- Creative, Technical & Vocational
- Enrichment



2.4.2.1 Core Syllabuses (Setswana, English Language, Mathematics)

Table 2.1 shows performance in the Core syllabuses at Grade G or better, E or better and C or better for 2020 and 2019.

The syllabuses of Setswana and Mathematics continued to record slightly more than a third of candidates achieving credit grades (C or better), whilst English Language remained low at this level with less than 20% of candidates achieving credit grades. This level of performance in English Language is worrisome as most programmes at tertiary level require a credit in English Language as part of the entry requirements. Despite this observation, the performance in 2020 improved insignificantly throughout the grades C or better, E or better and G or better. On another note, Mathematics continue to record higher levels (about 8%) of candidates assigned U compared to English and Setswana both of which recorded less than 1% at U. This implies that about 8% of

candidates who studied Mathematics for two years at Senior Secondary will graduate with no permanent record of having done so.

2.4.2.2 Science Syllabuses (separate Sciences and the Award Sciences)

Table 2.2 shows performance in the Science syllabuses at Grade G or better, E or better and C or better for 2020 and 2019.

2.4.2.2.1 The Award Sciences

Performance in Science Single Award continues to be very low with about 30% of candidates awarded grade E or better and only 3% of those awarded grade C or better even though an insignificant improvement has been noted at this grade. Science Double is a popular option but it continues to record only around 50% of candidates awarded grade E or better with less than half of those being credit grades. This implies that generally the credit grades from the science subgroup will tend to be lower as the most popular option contributes less.

2.4.2.2.2 The separate Sciences

The performance in Chemistry remained unchanged at grade G or better with all candidates qualifying for the award of a grade, whilst Physics and Biology recorded insignificant improvements. All the three syllabuses recorded insignificant decline at grades E or better and C or better except for Biology which recorded an insignificant improvement at grade C or better. Despite these observations, it ought to be noted that the separate sciences continue to be the best performing syllabuses within the BGCSE suit.

2.4.2.3 Humanities and Social Sciences (History, Geography, Social Studies, Development Studies, Literature in English)

Table 2.3 shows the performance of candidates in the Humanities and Social Science syllabuses at Grade G or better, E or better and C or better for 2020 and 2019.

Each of the syllabuses in the subgroup recorded less than 10% of candidates who were assigned U but History, as in 2019; contributed more candidates, about 9% when compared to the other four (4). Even though the changes observed are insignificant except for Geography and Literature in English at grade G or better, it is observed that a lot of the changes in this subgroup are on the negative side. Also worth noting is that History recorded a decline across grades G or better, E or better and C or better.

2.4.2.4 Creative, Technical & Vocational (Business syllabuses, Home Economics syllabuses, Agriculture, Design & Technology, Art & Design Computer Studies)

Table 2.4 shows the performance for syllabuses in the subgroup at Grade G or better, E or better and C or better for 2020 and 2019.

Although changes in most of the syllabuses in the subgroup are insignificant except Accounting and Business Studies at grade G or better and Art & Design at Grade C or better, most of the changes are in the positive direction.

2.4.2.5 The Business Syllabuses (Commerce, Business Studies, Accounting)

Of the three (3) syllabuses, Accounting continues to be the best performing with 80% of candidates awarded grade E or better and about 60% of those awarded credit grades. Business Studies and Commerce continue to record reasonable performance of around 60% at grade E or better but with only about 20% and 30% respectively, qualifying for credit grades. There is need to investigate the source of discrepancies in performance amongst the Business syllabuses.

2.4.2.6 Art & Design

Art & Design syllabus continues to record exceptionally high levels of performance across grades with at least 72% of candidates achieving grade C or better when compared to about 66% in 2019. The high levels of performance could be indicative of the fact that candidates following the syllabus could be having a high aptitude for it.

2.4.2.7 The Home Economics Syllabuses (Food & Nutrition, Fashion & Fabrics and Home Management)

Despite a record of over 70% at grade E or better in Food & Nutrition and Fashion & Fabrics, only close to 30% of them continue to qualify for credit grades whilst the corresponding proportion in Home Management is about 50%. There is need to investigate the source of discrepancies in performance amongst the Home Economics syllabuses.

2.4.2.8 Enrichment syllabuses (Physical Education, Religious Education, Music)

Table 2.5 shows performance for syllabuses in the Enrichment subgroup at E or better and C or better for 2020 and 2019.

Nearly all candidates; at least 99.97% in 2020 compared to 99.91% in 2019; who entered for each of the syllabuses in this subgroup qualified for a syllabus grade. However, Religious Education continues to be the least performing syllabus in the subgroup across grades E or better and C or better. The improved performance of 12.91% in the syllabus of Music should be interpreted with caution. As

stated earlier in this report, the size of the cohort for the syllabus is too small (less than 200 candidates) and its composition fluctuates across years, including in 2020 and thus comparisons may not be meaningful.

2.5 Qualitative description

The quality of work of the candidates is described for the syllabuses showing a significant decline in performance in at least one of the key grades.

Science Single Award and Science Double Award

Candidates demonstrated weaknesses in the component testing practical skills. It could be that candidates following these science options are not exposed to practical orientation during teaching and learning. There is need to investigate the instructional practices in these syllabuses.

Geography

Candidates demonstrated weaknesses in research skills, data manipulation and presentation.

Business Studies

Candidates demonstrated weaknesses in knowledge and understanding of business concepts.

Religious Education

Weaknesses were noted in knowledge and understanding of religious concepts.

2.6 Overall Performance

Government school candidates at this level sit for a minimum of eight syllabuses and this section reports overall performance in terms of the proportion of candidates achieving grades G or better, E or better and C or better on the best six syllabuses compared to the previous years.

From the table it can be concluded that the overall performance based on the best six syllabuses declined **insignificantly** but the quality of the cohort was slightly better than that of 2019 as shown by insignificant improvements at E or better and C or better. Worth noting is that the proportion of candidates achieving 6 Cs or better remains at around 20%.

2.8.1 Outstanding Performance

The criterion for outstanding performance in the BGCSE examination is achievement of at least six (6) A*s in eight (8) of the syllabuses that a candidate may have taken. The prospective number of candidates who met this criterion in 2020 is nineteen (19) from twelve (12) centres compared to 11 from 7 centres in 2019.

It is noted that this year there were four (4) candidates from one centre amongst the top achievers whilst the rest of the centres had 2 or 1. The top candidate achieved 11A* from 11 syllabuses in 2020 which was far better than in 2019 when the top candidate achieved 8A*, 1A and 1B from a total of 10 syllabuses. In 2018 the achievement was at 8A*, 2A and 1B from 11 syllabuses. It is noted that the top 2 candidates achieved the highest level of performance in the history of the BGCSE.

PART III: RESULTS ANALYSIS

3.1 Introduction

This part of the report presents an analysis of the final outcomes for all candidates who sat for the 2020 BGCSE examinations. The section will be presented along the following sub-headings:

3.2 Candidature

From a total of **36 557** candidates, **21 260 (58.16%)** were females and **15 297 (41.84%)** males.

Table 3.1 presents the number of candidates who registered for BGCSE examinations in each centre across 2 years, 2019 and 2020. A comparison of 2019 and 2020 candidature shows that of the centres with a decline of more than 10% in candidature, only one (Kagiso Senior) is a government centre. On the other hand, there are more government centres with an increase of 10% or more in candidature. However, it should be noted that the total increase of 49 candidates between 2019 (36 508 candidates) and 2020 (36 557 candidates) is not significant. It is therefore plausible to assert

that while there were significant declines in some centres, especially private centres, there were significant increase in others, particularly Government centres.

3.3 Number of candidates graded for each syllabus

Table 3.2 shows the total number of candidates (school candidates and private candidates) who were graded for each of the syllabi in the period from 2016 to 2020. It also shows the percentage change in candidature compared to the previous year. Candidates who failed to meet the minimum requirements for a syllabus are also included and denoted by X.

Generally, as shown in Table 3.2, in the year 2020 there was an increase in candidature in most subjects compared to 2019. The greatest increase in candidature was noted in French (27.08%) and Music (22.28%). The other subjects with an increase of more than 10% include Chemistry, Physics, Biology and Statistics. On the other hand, the subjects which showed a decrease in candidature are Human and Social Biology (20.11%) and Fashion & Fabrics (12.22%).

Table 3.3 shows the total number of grades awarded at each key grade which are grade G, grade E, grade C and grade A or better. The results indicate that of all the grades awarded, 96.04% were grades G or better, 74.74% were grades E or better and 30.20% were grades C or better, while those which were grade A or better (A and A*) constituted only 2.80%. This shows some improvements compared to 2019 at the same grades, with only grade G showing a decline.

Table 3.8 presents the number of candidates with 6 G's or better in Private schools. Majority of these schools have less than 20% of candidates with 6 G's or better. This imply that most of their candidates have either obtained grade U or even X. Only Oriel International Private school achieved 100% followed by a distant Thabitha Private Secondary School with 79.17% of 6G's or better. Some schools improved significantly e.g. Gabane Private School, Lekhubu Private school, Bosele secondary, while others declined significantly e.g. St Bernadettes Secondary School.

Appendix 1

PERFORMANCE OF CANDIDATES IN GOVERNMENT AND GOVERNMENT AIDED SCHOOLS

Tables AP1.1 to AP1.34 show the performance of candidates in the Government and Government Aided Schools in the period from 2015 to 2020. Only candidates in full-time attendance at the schools have been included. The performance of the candidates in each school is measured by calculating the number of grades awarded and the cumulative percentage at each grade. Changes in the performance of candidates in a particular school could be assessed by comparing the percentage of the grades issued which are grade C or better (the cumulative percentage at C). For example, in Table AP1.1 the proportion of all grades issued which are C or better increased from 23.32% in 2015 to 23.33% in 2016, then dropped to 19.66% in 2017 and increased to 21.11% in 2018 and then remained the same in 2019.
