POSITION REQUIREMENTS

Qualifications

Experience

At least three (3) years continuous teaching experience at BGCSE level relevant to the preferred syllabus or at institutions that prepares students for higher qualifications. Experience in moderation will be an added advantage.

All applicants must be in service at the institutions that prepare the candidates for the JCE qualification. They should also each indicate their preferred syllabus(es) provided they have teaching experience in those syllabuses.
