PART 1: ADMINISTRATION REPORT

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) examination is a syllabus-based assessment where candidates are awarded certificates in respect of each syllabus. This means that each syllabus is a stand-alone qualification with an independent grade awarded to candidates. The 2024 cohort comprised of candidates from public schools, private schools, Botswana Open University (BOU) and individual candidates who registered directly with the BEC. The administration report is intended to provide information regarding the environment under which the examinations were conducted.

1.1 REGISTRATION

1.1.1 Registration of Centres

A total of eighty-six (86) Centres were registered for the 2024 series, which comprised 51 school Centres (34 government and 17 private schools) and 35 private Centres (8 BOU and 27 BEC private Centres).

1.1.2 Registration of Candidates

Registration was conducted through the online facility of Malepa, for both school and private candidates.

A total of 36,917 candidates were registered in 2024 compared to 36,562 in 2023, which is an increase of 0.97%. Table 1 below shows the number of candidates who registered for the BGCSE examination in the past five years by Centre type.

1.2 Administration of examinations

The 2024 BGCSE examinations commenced with practical examinations at Centres from 11 to 27 September 2024 while the main written examinations were successfully conducted from 4th October 2024 to 20 November 2024.

1.3 COMPLIANCE TO EXAMINATIONS REGULATIONS

1.3.1 Training of Examining Personnel

BEC engages a variety of Examining personnel to ensure the examination processes are delivered according to specified standards. A total of one thousand, four hundred and twenty-one (1421) examining personnel were trained.

Table 2 represents the various personnel groups trained for the 2024 series.

1.3.2 Inspection of Centres by the BEC

BEC conducts centre inspections before and during live examinations to monitor the conduct of examinations and ensure compliance with the regulations. A total of one hundred and eighteen (118) compared to one hundred and six (106) in 2023 visits were conducted. In order to enhance visibility of BEC presence during the conduct of examinations, Regional Examination Administrators (REAs) were engaged to augment the BEC officers.

1.3.3 Cambridge *International* Inspections

BEC has an external accreditation partner in Cambridge University Press and Assessment (CUPA) and as part of the accreditation requirements, Cambridge inspects the conduct of examinations at BEC annually. For the 2024 series, the Cambridge Inspector conducted joint inspections with the BEC.

The outcomes of the Centre inspections in terms of the number and percentages of inspection ratings are summarized in Table 4.

The majority of Centres, 58% were rated as having satisfactorily conducted the exams while 42% were rated below expectations hence the need for BEC to follow up with such centres.

1.3.4 Examination Malpractice

A total of nine (9) incidents were reported, out of which three (3) were maladministration whilst six (6) were cases of suspected malpractice. The number of malpractice cases increased from three (3) in 2023 to six (6) in 2024, showing a worrisome development which will be closely monitored in the next cycle. Due to complexity in one of the cases, investigations are still ongoing. Table 6 details the cases.

1.4 MODERATION, COURSEWORK MARK SUBMISSION AND MARKING

This year, an improvement was noted in the submission of marks for coursework through Malepa as most centres complied with the deadlines for submission except for a few centres that did not meet the set timelines. The BEC will continue to provide support to centres in the next cycle to ensure adherence to deadlines. The Ministry of Child Welfare and Basic Education will also be engaged in strategies for improved implementation of Coursework at Centres.

1.4.1 Moderation

The BGCSE moderation of coursework components was conducted as scheduled. Sixteen (16) centres had to re-mark their projects from various syllabuses to ensure adherence to standards. The re-marking was at the expense of the centre as the centre personnel had not followed the procedure/criteria for marking coursework correctly.

1.4.2 Marking

The 2024 conventional and online marking were conducted successfully from 09 to 24 December 2024. The conventional marking was conducted at Mogoditshane Senior Secondary School and Phillip Moshotle Primary School while e-marking was conducted remotely. A novel online application called DataSmart was introduced. This application enhances the capturing of marks accurately into the system at the same time validating the marks so that there will be no need for data cleaning. The application also reduced the number of checkers engaged in the marking process.

A total of one thousand, seven hundred and sixty-five (1765) examining personnel were engaged in the marking exercise compared to one thousand, three hundred and twelve (1312) in 2023. Table 7 below indicates the number of examining personnel and type.

1.5 CANDIDATES WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

A number of applications were received from centres for access arrangements and special consideration. These two procedures are critical in improving access to BEC assessments for candidates with special needs. Candidates whose applications met the criteria for the two procedures were approved. As in previous years, there were candidates who did not benefit from the procedures due to the unavailability of documents to support their applications.

1.6 ACCESS ARRANGEMENTS

For 2024 examination series, a total of nine hundred and ten (910) applications were received compared to Seven hundred and ten (710) in 2023 showing an increase of 28.17%. Out of the 910 applications, 96.92% of the candidates provided supporting evidence while 3.08% did not.

1.6.1 Applications by Special Need Types

Most of the special need types recorded an increase as observed for Learning Difficulties and Hard of Hearing. Table 8 shows the number of applications for each of the Special Need types.

1.6.2 Applications by Access Arrangements type

At this level, an increase has been noted in almost all applications especially for Extra-time, Scribe/Oral Response (Learning Disability) and for candidates with Hearing Impairment as compared to 2023. A reduction has been noted for candidates with Visual Impairment (Enlarged print) and Hearing Impairment.

1.7 SPECIAL CONSIDERATION - APPLICATIONS BY CENTRES

A total of forty-seven (47) applications were received in 2024, Compared to Thirty-two (32) which were received in 2023. Out of these, three (3) candidates did not provide the required supporting evidence. All candidates who satisfied the eligibility criteria were specially considered while those that did not submit supporting evidence will be given six weeks after the release of the results to submit.

PART II TECHNICAL REPORT

2.0 INTRODUCTION

The report presents the provisional outcomes of the 2024 Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) examinations. It focuses on outcomes for the Government centre population only, which is considered stable, therefore enabling reliable comparisons across years.

The BGCSE is a syllabus-based qualification that reports achievement at syllabus level on a grade scale of A* to G, with A* being the highest achievement and G being the lowest. Candidates failing to reach the minimum standard for the award of the lowest grade are assigned letter U. In addition, those who do not meet the requirements for grading for various reasons are assigned letter X. Grading at BGCSE is conducted at component level and the component scores are then weighted and aggregated to obtain a syllabus grade. All components are designed for the ability range of grades A to G except for Mathematics components where paper 1 and 2 are designed for grades C to G (core route) while paper 3 is designed for grades A to C (extended route).

The assessment structure for the 2024 BGCSE was the same as that of 2023 and comprised of thirty-one (31) syllabuses. The syllabuses include the four (4) Outcome-Based Education (OBE) which were written for the first time in 2022. The Human & Social Biology syllabus is exclusively available to private candidates and therefore it is excluded from the comparisons. There were also three (3) borrowed syllabuses from Cambridge University Press and Assessment which are Additional Mathematics, Statistics and French. The 31 BGCSE syllabuses had a total of eighty-four (84) components: eight (8) Multiple-Choice, forty-five (45) constructed response, eighteen (18) practical and alternative to practical papers, and thirteen (13) coursework. The Multiple-Choice and constructed response include a component each for Human & Social Biology.

All the processes leading to the grading of the syllabuses were executed as per the procedures. The BGCSE is a high-stakes examination used primarily for selection into tertiary education and employment, therefore fairness in this type of assessment is of paramount importance. The BEC has ensured application of the same assessment standards to all candidates in this series.

The 2024 examination series provided candidates with an opportunity to show what they know and what they can do, and to the same level of demand as those who took the examination in previous years. Generally, all the scores for the coursework components were submitted thus allowing for the inclusion of coursework in the award of the syllabus grade, as per the curriculum expectations and the design of the assessment.

2.1 QUALITY OF THE ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENTS

The BGCSE question papers were developed by the Botswana Examinations Council and quality assured by Cambridge University Press and Assessment to ensure their suitability for the intended purpose. This section reports on the statistical parameters of the various question papers following their administration. It should be noted however that these

parameters are also sensitive to the ability of the cohort. The tests are designed for mixed ability groups whose abilities are assumed to be normally distributed. Therefore, the characteristics of large populations are expected to be similar across years unless where there have been significant interventions that may offset the usual characteristics.

The quality of the instruments is described mainly by the mean (average score) and the standard deviation (*SD*) (spread of scores from the mean). An ideal assessment instrument when administered to a population with normal distribution of ability, should yield a mean score that is about 50% of the maximum scores and a standard deviation of about 16% of the maximum scores. The Multiple-Choice components have additional parameters being the mean P and the alpha. The mean P is the item difficulty, and the alpha is a measure of the internal consistency of the instrument. However, the parameters for components with small population should be interpreted with caution.

2.1.1 Multiple Choice Components

Table 1 shows the 2024 statistical parameters in comparison to 2023 for the seven (7) Multiple-Choice components.

Difficulty Level (Mean P)

Generally, the question papers were of moderate difficulty. However, Chemistry, Physics and Biology were on the easier side as indicated by the Mean P values above .60. It is worth noting that these 3 syllabuses are offered to candidates of high ability, hence the higher Mean P.

Mean

The mean value for Science Single Award continues to be lower than the expected 50%. In contrary, the mean values for the separate Sciences, Chemistry, Physics and Biology, continue to be high. The population taking different Science options is most likely streamed by ability, therefore, affecting the mean values of the various Science options. The mean values for Commerce, Science Double Award and Agriculture are around the ideal value.

Score Variability (SD)s

Three syllabuses (Physics, Agriculture and Science Double Award) displayed variability within the acceptance level while the other components displayed a relatively narrow variability suggesting that scores were clustered around the mean.

Reliability (alpha)

All question papers except for Biology and Science Single Award recorded levels of reliability which are within the acceptable levels. The low reliability is attributable to the ability of the cohort taking the syllabuses.

2.1.2 Coursework Components

There are thirteen (13) syllabuses that have a coursework component, four (4) of which are the new pre-vocational OBE syllabuses.

2.1.3 Coursework Moderation

Conventional moderation was conducted for nine (9) syllabuses while four (4) syllabuses used statistical moderation. The nine syllabuses where conventional moderation was used are Art & Design, Design & Technology, Home Management, Fashion & Fabrics, Music, Animal Production, Field Crop Production, Horticulture and Hospitality & Tourism Studies. The four (4) syllabuses that used statistical moderation are Agriculture, Physical Education, Computer Studies, and Development Studies. The scores for all the four syllabuses were validated before moderation to ensure that the Centre scores were fit for purpose.

2.1.4 Technical Quality of Coursework Components

Table 2 shows the 2024 statistical parameters for thirteen (13) coursework components in comparison to 2023.

Generally, coursework components tend to record very high mean values and relatively small standard deviations. Music is the only component that recorded a mean value lower than 50%. However, what should be noted is that the syllabus has a very small population, and its parameters should be interpreted with caution. Similarly, Outcome Based Assessment (OBA) coursework components also have very small candidature. Almost all the coursework components had standard deviations lower than 12% which is a concern since the components are not spreading the candidates adequately as expected in high-stakes examinations. The narrower standard deviation is due to Centres awarding learners marks which are close together and highly inflated. There is a need for continual engagement with relevant stakeholders to improve the quality of coursework assessment.

2.1.5 Practical Tests

Table 3 shows the 2024 statistical parameters for the fifteen (15) practical tests that were administered to candidates in Government Centres in comparison to those of 2023.

Generally, most of the practical tests present mean values that are within desirable levels ranging from 40 – 60% except for the Science Single Award which presented a low mean value. On the other hand, Chemistry, Hospitality & Tourism Studies and Food & Nutrition continue to present high mean values which could be indicative of easy tests and/or a better cohort. The standard deviation for most of the components is within the desirable level except for Science Single Award, Biology, Food & Nutrition and Animal Production which did not separate the candidates very well in terms of their ability.

2.1.6 Constructed Response

There were forty-four (44) constructed response papers that were administered to candidates in 2024 just like in 2023. For purposes of reporting, the syllabuses are grouped as Core & Sciences and Optional & pre-vocational (Outcome Based Education).

2.1.6.1 Core and Science Syllabuses

Table 4 shows the statistical parameters for core and Science syllabuses.

Generally, most of the components in this category present desirable mean values between 40% and 60% (see Table 4) except for English 1 and Chemistry 3 which continue to be on

the easier side. Mathematics 2, Science Double Award 3 and Science Single Award 3 were slightly difficult. Most components displayed the SD that is within the desirable range except English 1, Setswana 1 and Science Single Award 3.

2.1.6.2 Optional and pre-vocational Syllabuses

Table 5 shows the statistical parameters of optional and pre-vocational constructed response components.

Optional Components

Generally, the mean values for all the components are within desirable levels except for History 1 & 2, Geography 1, Social Studies 2, Commerce 2 & 3, Agriculture 2, Food & Nutrition 1 and Music 1 as shown in Table 5. However, all the instruments differentiate the candidates very well according to ability.

Pre -vocational (Outcome Based Education Syllabuses)

The mean values for the OBE syllabuses are within the acceptable range except for Horticulture. Worth noting is that all the syllabuses have low candidature, and therefore their parameters are sensitive to small changes.

2.2 GRADING

2.2.1 The Process

Grading decisions at BGCSE are based on professional judgement and statistical evidence. The Principal Examiners provided professional judgement about the difficulty of the question papers and the quality of the candidates after completion of the marking. This was followed by pre-grading meetings which were held from 27th to 31st January 2025, where Executive Officers interrogated the professional judgement of the Principal Examiners against the statistical evidence. The Executive Officers ultimately recommended the grade thresholds which were presented to the Grading Advisory Committee (GAC) from 3rd to 7th February 2025 for further interrogation.

2.2.2 Membership of the GAC

The GAC had stakeholder representatives from the Department of Curriculum Development & Evaluation, Department of Educational Planning and Research Services, Botswana Open University, and the University of Botswana. There was also representation from Cambridge University Press and Assessment as an accreditation partner. The rest of the members were BEC Management staff from the Directorates of Assessment Design, Assessment Administration and Assessment Compliance. The Committee considered and approved the recommended grade thresholds for all the 31 BGCSE syllabuses, including Human and Social Biology.

2.2.3 Validation of Provisional Results

The process of results validation involves grade review, Interrogation of performance of centres that were identified for monitoring in the previous cycles, Centres with drastic changes in outcomes and consultation of Examinations Administration Incidents Log.

2.2.3.1 Centres Monitored from Previous cycles

There were no Centres earmarked for monitoring in 2024.

2.2.3.2 Grade Review

The process of grade review entails identification and a review of the marking of the scripts for candidates who are at a higher risk of being awarded an incorrect grade. The grade review was conducted from 11 – 13 February 2025 and data was updated where necessary.

2.2.3.3 Verification of Provisional Results

The process involves identifying Centres whose provisional results in a syllabus changed by $\pm 15\%$ from the previous year at any grade. The provisional results for the Centres with drastic changes were interrogated and nothing anomalous was detected.

2.2.3.4 Centres from Examinations Administration Incidents Log

The 2024 Examination Administration Incidents Log was consulted to identify incidents with the potential of compromising the integrity of the examination. There were nine (9) incidents that were reported across Centres. The reported cases were three (3) for maladministration and six (6) for suspected malpractice. The details of the incidents, including recommended penalties, were covered in the Examinations Administration report.

2.3 FINAL OUTCOME

The BGCSE is a syllabus-based qualification and therefore grades are awarded at syllabus level and there is no aggregation to determine a qualification grade. This section reports performance at syllabus and overall levels. The grades awarded in each syllabus are on a scale of A* to G. Candidates failing to reach the minimum requirement for grade G are assigned letter U. Candidates who did not meet the requirements for grading are assigned letter X at both component and syllabus level.

2.3.1 Performance at Syllabus Level

The performance at syllabus level is presented under two main groups: Core & Sciences and Optional & pre -vocational. There are forty-four (44) candidates from different Centres who did not meet the requirements for grading across syllabuses hence assigned letter X.

2.3.1.1 Core & Science Syllabuses

There are three (3) core syllabuses and five (5) science syllabuses; two (2) Award Sciences and three (3) separate sciences. Table 6 shows the performance of the candidates in the core and Science syllabuses at Grade G or better, E or better and C or better for 2023 and 2024.

The Core Syllabuses

Nearly all candidates met the minimum requirement to be awarded Grade G or better in the languages whilst in Mathematics about 10% of the candidates failed to meet the requirement hence are assigned letter U. However, Mathematics displayed improvement in Grade C or better and declined at Grade G or better. Generally, performance in languages has remained the same as the previous year across the grades C or better and G or better. Worth noting is that Setswana has shown improvement at Grade E or better. Performance at Grade C or better continues to be low for all the syllabuses.

The Award Sciences

Most of the candidates met the minimum requirement to be awarded Grade G or better in the Science Double Award while in Science Single Award about 12% of the candidates failed to meet the minimum requirement for Grade G hence are assigned letter U. Performance at Grade E or better has declined for Science Single Award while at Grade C or better continues to be stable but very low. The performance for Science Double Award has shown improvement in Grade E or better and Grade G or better.

The Separate Sciences

Almost all the candidates qualified to be awarded a syllabus grade in all the three separate Sciences. Generally, the performance in all the separate Sciences is more or less the same as that of the previous year across all the grades except in Physics where there is significant improvement at Grade C or better.

2.3.1.2 Optional Syllabuses

There are eighteen (18) syllabuses in this category. Table 7 shows the performance of the candidates at Grade G or better, Grade E or better and Grade C or better for 2023 and 2024.

Performance at Grade G or better

Five (5) syllabuses have shown significant improvement in performance at this category while the performance for the rest of the syllabuses remained more or less the same as in 2023. Business Studies continues to have the highest proportion of candidates (about 16%) who did not meet minimum requirements for the award of syllabus grade hence assigned letter U.

Performance at Grade E or better

Performance improved significantly in six (6) of the syllabuses and remained more or less the same in ten (10) syllabuses. A decline in performance is recorded in History and Music.

Performance at Grade C or better

Performance improved significantly in four (4) of the syllabuses and remained more or less the same in ten (10) syllabuses. There is a decline in performance in four (4) syllabuses.

2.3.1.3 Pre-Vocational (Outcome Based Education) Syllabuses

These are the Outcome Based Education syllabuses that were assessed for the third time in 2024. There are four syllabuses in this category. Table 8 shows the performance of the candidates at Grade G or better, E or better and C or better for 2023 and 2024.

Generally, this year there is significant improvement in performance across all grades for all OBE syllabuses. The largest improvement is observed at Grade C or better in Hospitality & Tourism Studies, Animal Production and Field Crop Production. All candidates met the minimum requirement to be awarded Grade G or better in Hospitality & Tourism Studies and Field Crop Production. Only a few candidates (about 5%) in Horticulture and Animal Production failed to meet minimum requirements for the award of syllabus grade.

This year, it was observed that candidates completed most of the tasks for provider-based assessments providing the learners an opportunity to gain knowledge and skills required in the syllabuses. In addition, it was noted that the candidature was of mixed ability unlike previous cohorts.

2.4 OVERALL PERFORMANCE

This section reports overall performance of candidates in Government Centres using three different measures:

- (a) The cumulative proportion of key grades awarded nationally from 2020 to 2024.
- (b) The proportion of candidates achieving 6 C's or better, 6 E's or better and 6 G's or better.
- (c) The proportion of candidates by numeric aggregate of six (6) best syllabuses.

2.4.1 The cumulative proportion of key grades awarded from 2020 to 2024

Table 9 shows the total number and cumulative proportion of key grades awarded nationally from 2020 to 2024.

The results indicate that among all the grades awarded this year, 96.88% were Grades G or better compared to 96.13 in 2023. The proportion of grades at E or better is 76.20% compared to 75.17% in 2023 which is an improvement of 1.03%. The proportion of grades at C or better is 33.39% compared to 32.94% indicating an improvement of 0.45%. The proportion of grades at A or better declined by 0.37%. The results show that generally, for the five years there has been a gradual improvement at Grade C or better.

2.4.2 The proportion of candidates awarded 6 C's or better, 6 E's or better and 6 G's or better.

Table 10 shows proportion of candidates awarded 6 C's or better, 6 E's or better and 6 G's or better.

Generally, performance has remained about the same for the five consecutive years. The proportion of candidates achieving 6 G's or better is 96.33% in 2024 compared to 95.07% in 2023 showing an improvement of 1.28%. The proportion of candidates achieving 6 E's or better improved by 1.61% from 62.28% to 63.89% in 2024. The proportion of candidates awarded 6 C's or better remained the more or less the same.

2.4.3 The proportion of candidates by numeric aggregate of six (6) best syllabuses

The BGCSE is a syllabus-based qualification and does not aggregate. However, some users of the results require aggregation. Therefore, Table 11 shows the proportion of candidates by numeric aggregate of six (6) best syllabuses for Government Centres. This aggregation is guided by the criteria used by Department of Tertiary Education Funding (DTEF).

The proportion of candidates obtaining 36 to 41 numeric aggregates are more or less the same at 27.20% compared to 27.44% in 2023. The proportion of candidates obtaining 30 to 35 numeric aggregates increased by 0.99% from 51.41% to 52.40% in 2024. An improvement was observed from numeric aggregate of 35 and below.

2.5 OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE

The criterion for determining outstanding performance in the BGCSE examination is through achievement of at least six (6) A*s in at least eight (8) of the syllabuses that a candidate may have taken. The provisional number of candidates who met this criterion in 2024 is twenty-two (22) from 10 Centres compared to twenty (20) from seven (7) Centres in 2023. Table 12 shows the profiles of the top candidates from 2020 to 2024.

PART III RESULTS ANALYSIS

3.0 INTRODUCTION

This part of the report presents an analysis of the final outcomes for **all** candidates who sat for the 2024 BGCSE examinations. These are candidates from Government Centres, Private Centres and individual candidates who registered directly with BEC and BOU.

3.1 CANDIDATURE

The total candidature who sat for the 2024 BGCSE was 36 917 compared to 36,562 in 2023 which represents minor increase of about 0.97%. There were 22 199 (60.13%) female candidates and 14 718 (39.87%) male candidates.

3.2 The Cumulative Proportion of Key Grades Awarded to all Candidates

Table 1 shows the total number and cumulative proportion of key grades awarded for **all** candidates from 2020 to 2024.

The results indicate that among all the grades awarded this year, 96.24% were Grades G or better compared to 95.80% in 2023. The proportion of grades at E or better is 74.77% compared to 75.00% in 2023. The proportion of grades at C or better is 31.35% compared to 32.30% in 2023. Moreover, the proportion of grades at A or better is 2.84% compared to 3.70% in 2023. The results indicate that generally performance across grades has been consistent for the last five years.

3.3 The Proportion of Candidates at each Numeric Aggregate of six (6) Best Syllabuses

The BGCSE is a syllabus-based qualification and does not aggregate. However, some users of the results require aggregation. Therefore, Table 2 shows the proportion of candidates at each numeric aggregate of six (6) best syllabuses for Government Centres. This aggregation is guided by the criteria used by Department of Tertiary Education Funding (DTEF).

There were 152 candidates achieved numeric aggregate of 48 points in 2024 compared 147 in 2023. The proportion of candidates obtaining 36 to 41 numeric aggregates stands at 17.70% in 2024 compared to 18.60% in 2023 which is a drop of 0.90%. The proportion of candidates obtaining 30 to 35 numeric aggregates decreased by 0.60% from 35.10% to 34.50% in 2024.

3.4 Overall Performance by Centre Type

The section compares the performance of candidates in public/government schools and private candidates (individual private candidates and those in private centres)

Generally, performance of candidates is higher in government centres compared to private Centres. The total grades awarded at G or better for public schools is 96.88 against 93.42% for private candidates. The total grades awarded at C or better for public school candidates is 33.39% compared to 22.31% for private candidates.

Females continue to outperform their males' counterparts. The total grades awarded at C better for females is 32.69% compared to 29.43% for males. A similar pattern was observed in 2023 where females outperformed their male counterparts. However, the performance for Females at C or better declined by 1.66% from 34.35% to 32.69%, whereas performance of males remains more or less the same from 29.70% to 29.43%.

3.6 Performance in Government schools

Table 5 shows the performance of candidates in the Government centres in 2023 and 2024. The performance in each school is reflected by the number of grades awarded and the cumulative percentage at each grade.

Naledi Senior Secondary School has the highest percentage of candidates awarded C or better at 43.55% although this is a slight decline of 1.34% obtained in 2023. The second highest is Shashe River School at 42.98% which is an improvement of 3.56%. Masunga Senior Secondary School follows with 42.18% against 41.72% in 2023. The next is Kgari Sechele II Senior Secondary School with 42.09% against 41.78% in 2023. Mater Spei college

improved by 2.77% from 38.44% to 41.21% in 2024. The rest of the Centres achieved proportions of Grade C or better below 40%. However, all Centres achieved proportions over 90% of candidates awarded a grade G or better.

This is followed by Medical Condition with 22 candidates who recorded 59.09% at grades A-C.

Table 13 shows the performance of candidates with various learning needs for Development. Studies has most of its candidates under Learning Disability category (185), these candidates recorded

22.70% at grades A-C. This is followed by Multiple Disabilities with (19) candidates who recorded 31.58% at grades A-C.

3.8 Outstanding Performance

The following list shows best performing candidates in the 2024 BGCSE examination.

The criterion for determining outstanding performance in the BGCSE examination is through achievement of at least six (6) A*s in at least eight (8) of the syllabuses that a candidate may have taken. The provisional number of candidates who met this criterion in 2024 is twenty-two (22) from 10 Centres compared to twenty (20) from seven (7) Centres in 2023. The profiles of the top candidates are shown below.

3.9 Summary of Results

- Candidature increased by **0.97%** from 36 562 in 2023 to 36 917 in 2024.
- Female candidates outnumber their male counterparts in majority of the subjects.
- There is vast variation in performance at Grade C or better between subjects, with Art & Design (81.54%) and Separate Sciences: Chemistry (88.33%), Physics (76.60%) and Biology (72.73%), among the highest performed subjects. On the other hand, Science: Single Award (4.74%), Human & Social Biology (6.90%) and Horticulture (8.33%) are the worst performed.
- At overall level, the results indicate that generally, performance across key grades (A, C, E, and G) has been consistent over the last five years. There is no significant difference.
- Female candidates significantly outperformed their male counterparts in quality Grades of A to C overall, and the majority of subjects, with few exceptions at Creative and Technical subjects such as Art & Design and Design & Technology.
- Few Centres obtained 40% or more pass rate on A-C grades in 2024 which is similar to 2023.
- Twenty-two (22) candidates achieved an outstanding performance compared to Twenty (20) in 2023.

3.10 PERFORMANCE OF CANDIDATES IN EACH SYLLABUS

Tables 3.38 to 3.71 show the performance of candidates in each of the BGCSE syllabi over a period of 5 years 2020, 2021, 2022, 2023 and 2024. They also show the number of grades awarded per syllabus and the cumulative percentage at each grade. For example, in Table 3.38, 17.18% of the candidates were awarded a minimum grade C for English in 2024 compared to 18.98% in 2023, signifying a 1.80% performance decrease.

PERFORMANCE OF CANDIDATES IN GOVERNMENT AND GOVERNMENT AIDED SCHOOLS

Tables AP1.1 to AP1.34 show the performance of candidates in the Government and Government Aided Schools in the period from 2019 to 2024. Only candidates in full-time attendance at the schools have been included. The performance of the candidates in each school is measured by calculating the number of grades awarded and the cumulative percentage at each grade. Changes in the performance of candidates in a particular school could be assessed by comparing the percentage of the grades issued which are grade C or better (the cumulative percentage at C). For example, in Table AP1.1 the proportion of all grades issued which are C or better in 2024 are 25.65%. 25.07% in 2023, 26.46% in 2022 and so on.
