## General Instructions and Guidelines

### 1 About this timetable

This timetable contains

- Instructions and guidelines about the examinations,
- a full list, in date order and sessions, of all the examinations,
- schedules of coursework and moderation timelines,
- Schedules of practical examinations,
- the key to the timetable.

The timetable must be followed throughout. If there is any discrepancy between this timetable and any other documents such as Statements of Entry or labels on Question Paper packets, the timetable takes precedence over all other documents and the Head of Centre should contact the Director Assessment Administration at BEC for confirmation.

### 2 About the session

Examinations scheduled for the morning session should start at **8.00 am**; examinations in the afternoon should start at **2.00 pm**. See also Section 13 - Key Times and Full Centre Supervision for Cambridge Syllabuses.

### 3 Where there is more than one paper in a single session

In cases where there are two papers timetabled in the same examination session, candidates should be allowed a short supervised break between the papers. The supervised break should be no longer than 30 minutes.

The second question paper must not be given out until the full time allocated to the first paper has been allowed and the scripts, answer sheets and question papers for the first paper have been collected.

### 4 Time Allowance for Question Papers

Any time required for candidates to read through question papers, to study maps, etc, is already included in the duration of the examination as shown on the timetable and on the front cover of the question paper. No additional time should be allowed, except for some Special Needs components of which specific instructions will be provided.

### 5 Syllabus 0596 Art & Design

The question papers for 0596/01 Observational Study, 0596/02 Interpretative Study and 0596/03 Design Study are delivered during early material question paper despatch. These question papers should be given to candidates immediately on receipt from BEC.

The examination is of 10 hours duration and should take place over two consecutive days. Candidates should sit 5 hours per day over 2 sessions of 2 hours 30 minutes; at 8am and 2pm on both days. **All Centres must timetable the examination from 22 to 23 September 2026.**

Since the dates of this examination are not reflected in the timetable and statement of entry, the Head of Centre must arrange for all candidates to be informed of the dates.

### 6 0611/02 Food & Nutrition

The Planning Session for this Practical Examination will take place on **06 August 2026** starting at **8.00 am**. **All Centres must timetable the Practical Examination from 07 to 18 September 2026.**

The dates of the Planning Session and the Practical Examination do not appear on the candidates' Statement of Entry. The Head of Centre must arrange for all candidates to be informed of the dates of the planning session and the practical examination.

### 7 1254/02 Hospitality & Tourism Studies

The Planning Session for this Practical Examination will take place on **10 August 2026** starting at **8.00 am**. **All Centres must timetable the examination from 09 to 18 September 2026.**

The dates of the Planning Session and the Practical Examination do not appear on the candidates' Statement of Entry. The Head of Centre must arrange for all candidates to be informed of the dates of the planning session and the practical examination.

### 8 Practical Examinations in 0570/04 Chemistry, 0571/04 Physics, 0572/04 Biology and 0597/01 Computer Studies

For the Practical Examinations in 0570/04 Chemistry, 0571/04 Physics, 0572/04 Biology and 0597/01 Computer Studies, the Head of Centre must arrange a number of consecutive sessions of the examination. In such cases, there should be no contact between candidates who have taken the test in one session and those who are scheduled to take the test in a later session.

### 9 0617/02 Music Performing

The Performing Examination of 0617/02 Music will take place during the period **07 to 18 September 2026**. **All Centres must timetable the examination on the scheduled dates.**

The date of the Performing Examination will not appear on the candidates' Statement of Entry. The Head of Centre must arrange for all candidates to be informed of the date of the Practical Examination.

### 10 0520/03 French Speaking Test

The 0520/03 French Speaking Test will take place between **15 September and 16 October 2026**. **All Centres must timetable the examination on the scheduled dates.** The date of the Speaking Test will not appear on the candidates' Statement of Entry. The Head of Centre must arrange for all candidates to be informed of the date of the Speaking Test.

**Speaking Test Marks should be uploaded into the "Submit For Assessment" portal, before 23 October 2026. Following the submission of the Speaking Test Marks on to the "Submit For Assessment" portal, the system will provide a list of sampled candidates for the Centre to upload on to the portal.**

A copy of the completed **Speaking Examination Working Mark Sheet** should reach BEC not later than **23 October 2026**.

## 11 Submission of Coursework and Coursework Marks

Centres that have registered candidates for syllabuses with a coursework component should **submit their marks through Malepa on the stipulated dates** as indicated on **page 11** of this Timetable. In addition, syllabus specific guidelines on moderation of coursework and deliverables will be provided by the BEC. Centres are also required to keep a back up copy of the coursework marks.

## 12 Examination Malpractice

**Centres should be aware that examination malpractice is classified as a criminal offence, and that there are sanctions and penalties which may lead to loss of marks, disqualification, or barring from examinations of candidates or the Centre.**

- The Head of Centre should ensure that teachers, invigilators and candidates are made aware of their responsibility in guarding against malpractice, as well as the consequences thereof. All work submitted must be the candidate's authentic work.
- The centre should ensure that there is no collusion, copying, impersonation or any other suspicious acts during examinations.

## 13 Key Times and Full Centre Supervision: Cambridge International Syllabuses

Centres that have registered to take Cambridge International GCE Ordinary Level and IGCSE syllabuses should observe that Cambridge International requires that at the Key Times stipulated below, all candidates must be under Full Centre Supervision for security purposes. Syllabuses which are affected include; 4037 - Additional Mathematics, 4040 - Statistics and 0520 - French.

The **Key Times** are **11.00 am** local time for the morning sessions and **3.00 pm** local time for the afternoon sessions. In the October/November 2026 series all of the examination papers concerned are written in the morning session.

The morning session for examinations will start at **8.00 am** local time. Candidates who will be writing Cambridge International Examinations will therefore finish before the **Key Time of 11.00 am**. Since the **Key Time** is after the end of the examinations, all candidates **must remain under Full Centre Supervision until 11.00 am**.

Candidates can either be under **Full Centre Supervision** in the examination rooms with their invigilators or when they leave the examination rooms, they must be under **Full Centre Supervision** with their invigilators continuously until the **Key Time**.

During the period between the end of the examination and **11.00 am**, candidates can have access to their printed books and notes. The books and notes should not be on an electronic device. The candidates can talk to each other provided that they do not cause any disturbance to other candidates who are still doing an examination. However, candidates must not have access to telephones, cell phones, laptops/computers, smart watches or any electronic device with or without internet access or any means of external communication. Candidates must not be allowed to communicate by any means whatsoever with anyone who is not under **Full Centre Supervision**. As soon as the **Key Time** has passed, the candidates may be released.

## 14 General Notes

**The Invigilator's Manual and the timetable should be in each examination room at all times for the duration of the examinations.**

- The Chief Invigilator must ensure that the correct question paper packet is opened on the scheduled time in the timetable.
- **At the beginning** of each examination session, sealed packets of the question papers should be opened by the Invigilator in the presence of the candidates.
- **Before opening each envelope**, the Invigilator should confirm with candidates that the paper is the timetabled one.
- **At the end** of each examination, scripts and answer sheets should be sealed in the presence of the candidates.
- The **attendance register and seating plan** for each of the scheduled examinations should be completed for each examination session. **Candidates should individually append their signatures against their names on the attendance register before being dismissed from the examination room.**
- The Chief Invigilator must also indicate absent candidates and sign at the bottom of each page of the attendance register to confirm the information provided.
- Projects, scripts and answer sheets will be collected from Centres. Communication will be made to Centres regarding arrangements for the collection of the scripts.
- **Centres should follow the guidelines for conduct of examinations at all times.**
